# INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

## Report on Schedules

We have audited the accompanying schedule of employer allocations of the Vermont Municipal Employees' Retirement System Cost-Sharing Multiple Employer Defined Benefit Pension Plan (VMERS or the Plan) as of and for the year ended June 30, 2021, and the related notes.

We have also audited the total for all entities of the columns titled net pension liability, total deferred outflows of resources, total deferred inflows of resources, and total employer pension expense (specified column totals), included in the accompanying schedule of pension amounts by employer of VMERS as of and for the year ended June 30, 2021, and the related notes.

## Management's Responsibility for the Schedules

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these schedules in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of the schedules that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

## Other Matter

We have audited, in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, the financial statements of the State of Vermont as of and for the year ended June 30, 2021, and our report thereon, dated December 23, 2021, expressed an unmodified opinion on those financial statements. VMERS is reported as a pension trust fund in the financial statements of the State of Vermont.

## (1) Plan Description

The Vermont Municipal Employees' Retirement System (VMERS or the System) is a cost-sharing, multiple-employer defined benefit pension plan that is administered by the State Treasurer and its Board of Trustees. It is designed for school districts and other municipal employees that work on a regular basis and also includes employees of museums and libraries if at least half of that institution's operating expenses are met by municipal funds. An employee of any employer that becomes affiliated with the system may join at that time or at any time thereafter. Any employee hired subsequent to the effective participation date of their employer who meets the minimum hourly requirements is required to join the system. During the year ended June 30, 2021, the retirement system consisted of 352 participating employers.

The plan was established effective July 1, 1975, and is governed by Title 24, V.S.A. Chapter 125.
The general administration and responsibility for formulating administrative policy and procedures of VMERS for its members and their beneficiaries is vested in the Board of Trustees consisting of five members. They are the State Treasurer, two employee representatives elected by the membership of the system, and two employer representatives--one elected by the governing bodies of participating employers of the system, and one selected by the Governor from a list of four nominees. The list of four nominees is jointly submitted by the Vermont League of Cities and Towns and the Vermont School Boards Association.

The Pension Plan is divided into four membership groups:

- Group A - general employees whose legislative bodies have not elected to become a member of Group B or Group C
- Groups B \& C - general employees whose legislative bodies have elected to become members of Group B or Group C
- Group D - sworn police officers, firefighters and emergency medical personnel

All assets are held in a single trust and are available to pay retirement benefits to all members. Benefits available to each group are based on average final compensation (AFC) and years of creditable service, and are summarized below:

Members of all groups may qualify for vested deferred allowance, disability allowances and death benefit allowances subject to meeting various eligibility requirements. Benefits are based on AFC and service.

## (2) Basis of Presentation

The schedules of employer allocations and schedule of pension amounts by employer (the Schedules) present amounts that are elements of the financial statements of VMERS or of its participating employers. Accordingly, they do not purport to be a complete presentation of the net position or changes in net position of VMERS or its participating employers. The amounts presented in the Schedules are prepared in accordance with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles. Such preparation requires management of VMERS to make a number of estimates and assumptions relating to the reported amounts. Due to the inherent nature and uncertainty of these estimates, actual results may differ from these estimates.

## (3) Allocation Methodology and Reconciliation to the Financial Statements

GASB Statement No. 68, Accounting and Financial Reporting for Pensions, requires participating employers in VMERS to recognize their proportionate share of the collective net pension liability, collective deferred inflows of resources, collective deferred outflows of resources and collective pension expense. The employer allocation percentages presented in the Schedule of Employer Allocations and applied to amounts presented in the Schedule of Pension Amounts by Employer are based on the ratio of each employer's contribution to VMERS to the total employer contributions during the measurement period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Contributions from employers are recognized when due, based on statutory requirements.

Title 24 VSA Chapter 125 of Vermont Statutes grants the authority to the Retirement Board to annually review the amount of municipalities' contributions as recommended by the actuary of the retirement system in order to achieve and preserve the financial integrity of the fund, and to certify the rates of contributions payable by employers. Employer contribution rates for the year ended June 30, 2021 for each group are as follows:

- Group A - $4.50 \%$ of gross salary
- Group B - $6.00 \%$ of gross salary
- Group C - $7.75 \%$ of gross salary
- Group D - $10.35 \%$ of gross salary

The long-term expected rate of return on pension plan investments was determined using a building-block method in which best-estimate ranges of expected future real rates of return (expected returns, net of pension plan investment expense and inflation) are developed for each major asset class. These ranges are combined to produce the long-term expected rate of return by weighting the expected future real rates of return for each major asset class included in the pension plan's target asset allocation as of June 30, 2021, and is summarized in the following table:

## (b) Discount Rate

The discount rate used to measure the total pension liability was $7.00 \%$ as of June 30 , 2021. The projection of cash flows used to determine the discount rate assumed plan member and employer contributions will be made at rates set by the Board (employers) and statute (members) with scheduled increases through July 1, 2022. Further, based upon Board resolution, projected contributions beginning July 1, 2022, and each subsequent July 1, through 2025 include additional total contribution increases of $0.50 \%$ per year. For this purpose, only employer contributions that are intended to fund benefits of current plan members and their beneficiaries are included. Projected employer contributions that are intended to fund the service costs of future plan members and their beneficiaries, as well as projected contributions from future plan members, are not included. Based on those assumptions, the pension plans' Fiduciary Net Position was projected to be available to make all projected future benefit payments of current plan members as of June 30, 2021. Therefore, the long-term expected rate of return on pension plan investments was applied to all periods of projected benefit payments to determine the total pension liability.

## (c) Sensitivity of the Net Pension Liability to Changes in the Discount Rate

The following presents the net pension liability, calculated using the discount rate of $7.00 \%$, as well as what the net pension liability would be if it were calculated using a discount rate that is one percentage point lower ( $6.00 \%$ ) or one percentage point higher ( $8.00 \%$ ) than the current rate:
